LOO ROLL	•
FLOWERS	
Bring plant life to your walls with these pretty flowers made from loo rolls!	7

You'll need:

- 3 cardboard toilet roll tubes \Rightarrow Split pins
- Paper clips

- \Rightarrow Card (inside of a cereal box)

Colour two rolls in your chosen flower colour(s). Then mark and cut the rolls into 1-cm pieces, making about 10 hoops per roll.

Make petals by flattening the hoops and join four petals with the PVA glue to form a flower. Use paper clips to hold in place until dry.

Arrange the flowers on a flat surface and add the stem and leaves to join the flowers together. Attach using PVA glue and a paper clip until dry. Mount your flowers on recycled card using a split pin in the middle of each flower and through the cardboard to attach. Make the stems and leaves by colouring the other roll and cutting it into 1-cm hoops. Cut some so they are strips to make stems and flatten others to make leaves. You can curl some using a pencil.
