BBQ SKEWER FALL © ROULETTE

Challenge your friends to skilfully remove the sticks without the bottle tops falling!


You'll need:

- 2 × 2-litre PET plastic bottles
- Wooden / bamboo skewers (cleaned)
- Piece of used paper large enough to wrap around a bottle (or stick two together)
- Used bottle tops (cleaned)

Cut off the top sections of two plastic bottles and smooth the edges with a file.



Cut a narrow V shape 8 cm up into one bottle. Fit this bottle inside the other bottle. With a marker pen, mark a point on both bottles, where the two bottles meet.



On your paper, draw a grid with lines 2 cm apart. Draw small circles on the alternate line intersections to mark out where to make your holes.



Wrap the paper grid around the bottles and secure with tape. Carefully make the holes using the circles from Step 3 as a guide.



Take off the paper grid and slide the two bottles apart.

Get your bottle tops and put them into one of the bottles.

Join the bottles back together so the marks line up. Feed all the skewers into holes and out the other side (they don't have to line up). Turn the bottle over to play the game, with the bottle tops above the skewers. Take it in turns to remove a skewer at a time. Whoever removes the skewer that makes the bottle tops fall loses!
